	Getting there: Walk from Lok Ma Chau Station to Shenzhen Metro Futian Checkpoint Station and take Line 4. Get off at Mission Hills Station and transfer to the Bus No. M258 at Exit A. Get off at Printmaking Base Stop and walk about 2 minutes.

There is a nice restaurant that costs you only RMB100 or so per head with a great selection of seafood, such as Argentine red shrimp, oysters, abalone, crab, octopuses and mussels. At Sace	After a scrumptious buffet, hit the Karoo Ice and Snow World at the Mission Hills Resort. This national 5A-level indoor ski venue features classic snowy scenery at -5°C to -3°C all year round. The snow is just as powdery as the natural. Boasting a 100m x 20m ski slope, this attraction gives so much fun to snow lovers even in summer. There are more than 10 outdoor hot spring pools, including those featuring herbs, petals or milk, with different functions and characteristics. Our top pick would be the herbal one, which relaxes muscles and nerves and helps you refresh yourself quickly.

	Getting there: Walk from Lok Ma Chau Station to Shenzhen Metro Futian Checkpoint Station on foot and take Line 4. Get off at Niuhu Station and transfer to the Bus No. M258 or B878 at Exit D. Get off at Junzibu Village Entrance Stop and walk about 1 minute.
