Walk from Lok Ma Chau Station to Shenzhen Metro Futian Checkpoint Station and take Line 4. Transfer to Line 6 at Hongshan Station and then get off at Yangtai Mountain East Station. Walk about 10 minutes from Exit A to Dalang entrance of the park.

Walk from Lok Ma Chau Station to Shenzhen Metro Futian Checkpoint Station. Take Line 4 and get off at Longhua Station. Walk about 8 minutes from Exit A.
