

## 【Shenzhen】Nostalgic green trains Three Express Trains Museum - A railway journey to the past!



In the 1960s, with a view to ensuring the supply of meat and vegetables to Hong Kong people, the “Three Express Trains”, numbered 751, 753 and 755, ran three times a day to Hong Kong via Luohu. These three express trains were also known as the “lifeline” of Hong Kong. Built in 1986, the Shenzhen Industrial Station has fulfilled its historical mission as the last interchange station for the “Three Express Trains” in Mainland. It has now become the railway-themed Qingshuihe Railway Park and the Three Express Trains Museum, both of which are must-visit attractions for railway enthusiasts and good places for the public to visit.



Located at the Industrial Station in Qingshuihe, Luohu District, the Museum preserves traces of the railway in the early 1960s. In 2010, having fulfilled its mission, the historical Industrial Station was transformed into China’s first Three Express Trains Museum, an immersive railway cinema and a railway leisure park. Bearing witness to the passage of time on the railway tracks and green trains, the Museum has attracted many visitors to take photos. Strolling along the railway tracks, visitors can experience the scenes of the past. Sitting in the coffee and book bar inside the green train compartments, they can enjoy the nostalgic atmosphere.



The Museum also shows the development history of the “Three Express Trains” from 1962 to 2010. On the other side of the wall, you can see that the Industrial Station has supplied Hong Kong and Macao with countless live pigs, live cattle, frozen meat, poultry, fruits and vegetables over a period of 48 years, showcasing the glorious history of the retired trains.

### 【Qingshuihe Railway Park and the Three Express Trains Museum】

Address: 112 Qingshuihe 1st Road, Qingshuihe Street, Luohu District, Shenzhen

Getting there:

1. From downtown area: Take Shenzhen Metro Line 3. Get off at Caopu Station and walk about 5 minutes from D3.
2. From East Rail Line Lo Wu Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro LuoHu Station on foot. Take Line 1 and then transfer to Line 3 at Laojie Station.
3. From East Rail Line Lok Ma Chau Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Futian Checkpoint Station on foot and take Line 10. Transfer to Line 14 at Gangxia North Station and then transfer to Line 3 at Buji Station.
4. From High Speed Rail Futian Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Futian Station on foot and then take Metro Line 3.

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
