

**【Shenzhen】 Artron Art Centre**  
**All you can read in a 30-metre high wall of books!**



Did you know that Shenzhen is home to the largest art book wall in the world? This remarkable book wall can be found at the Artron Art Centre. Bathed in sunlight, it resembles a massive ship sailing towards a treasure trove of knowledge. Inside the six-storey dark blue Artron Art Centre stands the Artron Wall, an internet-famous bookshelf with an extensive range of valuable books from around the globe. With a width of 50 metres, a height of 30 metres and a collection of 50,000 books, this enormous wall of books is indeed a visual wonder that received the Red Dot Design Award 2015 under the Communication Design category in Germany.

Artron Art Centre houses a wide spectrum of books, many of which are not for sale. They come in different languages including Chinese, Japanese, English, French, Italian and German, and cover a variety of topics from art and culture to photography. In addition to the Artron Wall, different types of arts exhibitions, including an exhibition with Potala Palace's murals, a digital and interactive exhibition of the Palace Museum's Hall of Mental Cultivation and other massive exhibitions, have been organised at the Art Centre since its inception in 2015, making it the focal point for art enthusiasts and artists.

Getting there:

1. From downtown area: Take Shenzhen Metro Line 2. Get off at Qiaocheng North Station and walk about 20 minutes from Exit D.
2. From East Rail Line Lo Wu Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro LuoHu Station on foot. Take Line 1 and then transfer to Line 2 at Window of the World Station.
3. From East Rail Line Lok Ma Chau Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Futian Checkpoint Station on foot. Take Line 4 and then transfer to Line 2 at Civic Center Station
4. From High Speed Rail Futian Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Futian Station on foot and take Line 2.
