Located in Lo Wu District, Honghu Park is best known for the abundance of lotus flowers in its lake. The park is most popular in summer when the lotus flowers are in full bloom. In autumn and winter, the densely planted bald cypresses along the lake create another eye-catching scene. During these seasons, the park is adorned with the red hues of the bald cypresses. These elegant trees, some standing on land and others in the blue water, give Honghu Park a distinct autumn and winter charm.



As autumn and winter approach, the leaves of the bald cypresses on land gradually turn golden yellow and red, painting a beautiful picture against the blue sky and white clouds. Meanwhile, the bald cypresses in the lake cast mottled shadows on the clear water. Walking among the bald cypresses, people would feel as though they had stepped into a dreamy fairy tale world. The bird island in the centre of the lake is home to egrets and other water birds. The birds come and go, unafraid of visitors, adding life and vitality to the park.



With the passing of autumn and winter, the red leaves of the bald cypresses turn green, signalling the return of summer, while the lotus flowers begin to bloom in the lotus pond. The scenery of Honghu Park changes with each season, attracting countless visitors yearround to experience the rare tranquillity of the city.

Getting there:

- 1. From downtown area: Take Shenzhen Metro Line 7. Get off at Honghu station and walk about 7 minutes from Exit D.
- 2. From East Rail Line Lo Wu Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Luohu Station on foot and take Line 1. Transfer to Line 3 at Laojie Station and then transfer to Line 7 at Tianbei Station.
- 3. From East Rail Line Lok Ma Chau Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Futian Checkpoint Station on foot. Take Line 4 and then transfer to Line 7 at Fumin Station.
- 4. From High Speed Rail Futian Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Futian Station on foot. Take Line 3 and then transfer to Line 7 at Huaxin Station.
