

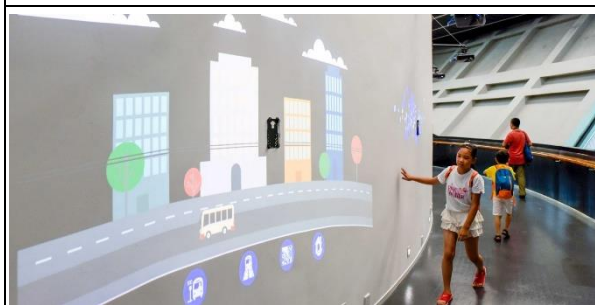
【Shenzhen】Red Cube Shenzhen museum complex home to new tech!



Located in Longgang, Shenzhen, the Red Cube consists of “three museums and one city”. The four buildings, with a cohesive red design and unique shapes, include the Science and Technology Museum, the Public Art and Urban Planning Museum, Children’s Palace and the Shenzhen Longgang Book City. Among them, the Science and Technology Museum is the most popular, boasting seven floors and five major exhibition areas, namely “The Foundation of Science”, “The Rise of Industry”, “The Path of Science and Innovation”, “The Mystery of Life” and “The Dream of the World”.



The museum showcases numerous technological installations and exhibits, most of which incorporate games and interactive experiences, breaking the stereotype of boring technology exhibitions. Programmes like Chess with Robots and Dialogue with Robots are sure to delight children and adults alike.



Beyond painting, sculpture, photography and other art forms, the Public Art and Urban Planning Museum also features exhibitions on the history of art and design. Here, children can explore the evolution and development of art and design in daily life. Meanwhile, Children’s Palace offers video games and rock-climbing activities for older children to enjoy. After a fun-filled day, children and adults can also shop for books at the Book City to enrich their minds.

Getting there:

1. From downtown area: Take Shenzhen Metro Line 3. Get off at Longcheng Square Station and walk about 13 minutes from Exit D.
2. From East Rail Line Lo Wu Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Luohu Station on foot. Take Line 1 and then transfer to Line 3 at Laojie Station.
3. From East Rail Line Lok Ma Chau Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Futian Checkpoint Station on foot and take Line 10, transfer to Line 14 at Gangxia North Station and then transfer to Line 3 at Universiade Station.
4. From High Speed Rail Futian Station: Get to Shenzhen Metro Futian Station on foot and then take Metro Line 3.
