#### **MTR Offers a Year of Free Rides and Broadcasts Key Events in Nine Malls In Supporting Hong Kong Athletes at Paris 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games**

With the Paris 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games approaching, Hong Kong athletes are actively preparing themselves to deliver their best performances in the competitions and bring glory to Hong Kong. To show support and cheer for the athletes, MTR Corporation will arrange live broadcasts of key events at MTR Malls during the Games, as well as offer one-year free rides to all Hong Kong athletes competing in the Games.

To provide support to the athletes and their supporting teams, MTR Corporation will also offer a total of 200 free Airport Express train tickets to the athletes participating in the Games through the Sports Federation & Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China, together with the previous commitment of a total of 1,200 Airport Express train tickets to the China Hong Kong Paralympic Committee, for their preparation in the Paris 2024 Paralympic Games and other sporting events<sup>1</sup>.
