MTR Facilitates Passengers Travel in Celebrating the Mid-Autumn Festival with Overnight Services and Enhanced Train Services

To facilitate passengers' travel in celebrating the Mid-Autumn Festival, MTR Corporation will enhance train services during the festival (17 September 2024). All MTR railway lines (except the Airport Express, Disneyland Resort Line, and journeys to or from Lo Wu and Lok Ma Chau stations on the East Rail Line) and some Light Rail lines will also provide overnight services, with a total of around 520 train trips added.

Starting from 3 pm on the Mid-Autumn Festival, eight MTR railway lines will gradually enhance service with evening peak train frequencies to facilitate members of the public to travel after work. The Island Line, Tsuen Wan Line, Kwun Tong Line (between Tiu Keng Leng and Ho Man Tin stations), and Tseung Kwan O Line (between North Point and Tseung Kwan O stations) will run train trips at about 2-minute intervals after enhancement. After 8 pm, the Island Line, Tsuen Wan Line, and Kwun Tong Line will also provide more frequent train services than usual in the evenings, with trains running every three to four minutes, for the convenience of those out celebrating the full moon.

All local railway lines (except the Airport Express, Disneyland Resort Line, and journeys to or from Lo Wu and Lok Ma Chau stations on the East Rail Line) and seven Light Rail routes (including 505, 507, 610, 614P, 615P, 706 and 751) will operate overnight. In addition, MTR Bus routes 506, K51, and K54 will extend their service hours. (Please refer to the Annex for details on enhanced train services and overnight services.)

The Corporation will continue to closely monitor train operations and suitably adjust train service when necessary. MTR Corporation wishes passengers a joyful Mid-Autumn Festival celebration with their families and friends.
