MTR Offers Free Rides to the Elders aged 65 or above on Senior Citizen's Day on 17 November 2024

The annual Senior Citizen's Day will be held on 17 November (Sunday) this year. The MTR Corporation is committed to connecting to the community and is pleased to continue supporting Senior Citizen's Day on 17 November 2024 (Sunday) by offering free rides to elders aged 65 or above. On Senior Citizen's Day, elders aged 65 or above using either their JoyYou Card, Elder Octopus or Personalised Octopus can enjoy free rides on the MTR¹, Light Rail and MTR Bus. No fare will be deducted when eligible elders use their cards to enter and exit the ticket gates and Light Rail platform processors or board MTR Bus.
