"Come and Enjoy a 'Pandastic' MTR Ride" Debuts on High Speed Rail Panda-themed High Speed Rail Train Shuttles Between Guangdong and Hong Kong Offering an Immersive "Panda" Journey for Passengers

The "Come and Enjoy a 'Pandastic' MTR Ride" introduced by the MTR Corporation earlier, brings the six pandas of the panda family - Ying Ying, Le Le, An An, Ke Ke, and a pair of twin cubs "Elder Sister, Little Brother" onto Hong Kong's public transportation, and has been well received by passengers. Starting from 11 January 2025 (Saturday), the MTR Corporation, in collaboration with the Hong Kong Tourism Board, will introduce the Panda Family to the Vibrant Express train on the High Speed Rail (Hong Kong Section) ("HSR"). Passengers traveling on designated trips from Hong Kong West Kowloon Station to Shenzhen or Guangzhou will have the opportunity to interact with the adorable panda family.

The Panda-themed HSR train will make a 12-week appearance, calling on friends traveling between Hong Kong, Shenzhen, and Guangzhou to join in the panda frenzy! Hong Kong West Kowloon Station has also been decorated with a panda theme, allowing the lively and cute pandas to embark passengers on a fun-filled cross-boundary journey. As partners with the Leisure, Sports and Tourism Bureau, the Hong Kong Tourism Board, and the Ocean Park Hong Kong in promoting the Panda campaign, the Corporation leverages its extensive railway network to seamlessly connect the panda-themed events with communities, contributing to the success of this initiative.

Panda-themed HSR Train

The HSR "Hong Kong Panda Special Train" features a complete makeover both inside and outside the train. From the train body and the windows and luggage racks to the doors, various cute and playful panda expressions can be seen. The mischievous and charming pandas not only act as HSR train captain but also serve as promotional ambassadors, appearing amid various Hong Kong landmarks to introduce photo spots to passengers. The "Hong Kong Panda Special Train" will run on specified services between Hong Kong West Kowloon and Guangzhounan, Shenzhenbei, and Futian stations on Saturdays, Sundays, and designated days from 11 January to 4 April (please refer to the annex for details). On weekdays, the Panda Special Train will randomly operate on the above short-haul services, anticipating surprising encounters with passengers!
