MTR Provides Overnight Services on Lunar New Year's Eve Enhances Train Services During Lunar New Year to Facilitate Festive Celebrations

To provide the public with convenient transportation for festive celebrations, MTR Corporation will step up train services on various lines starting from tomorrow (24 January 2025), adding a total of over 1,600 additional train trips throughout the Lunar New Year period. The enhancements include overnight services on Lunar New Year's Eve and increased train frequencies during the fireworks display around Victoria Harbour on the Second Day of Lunar New Year, facilitating journeys for the public and tourists to both sides of Victoria Harbour to enjoy the fireworks.

From this Friday to the Seventh Day of the Lunar New Year (24 January to 4 February), train frequencies along four railway lines, including the Island Line, Tsuen Wan Line, East Rail Line and South Island Line, will be enhanced during designated periods on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays. Meanwhile, the East Rail Line and Disneyland Resort Line will run more train trips on most of the days over the period. (For details on the enhanced train services, please refer to the Annex)

On Lunar New Year's Eve (28 January), eight local railway lines will start operating at evening peak frequencies at 3:00pm, among which the Island Line, Tsuen Wan Line, Kwun Tong Line and Tseung Kwan O Line (between North Point and Tseung Kwan O stations) will be running about every two minutes. All local railway lines (excluding journeys to or from Lo Wu and Lok Ma Chau stations on the East Rail Line, Airport Express and Disneyland Resort Line) and seven Light Rail routes will also provide overnight services on the same night, while three MTR bus routes will extend their service hours. Meanwhile, the High Speed Rail (Hong Kong Section) will operate as usual.

In light of the fireworks display around Victoria Harbour on the Second Day of Lunar New Year (30 January), train frequencies will be enhanced on seven railway lines (Kwun Tong Line, Tsuen Wan Line, Island Line, South Island Line, Tuen Ma Line, East Rail Line and Tung Chung Line) to facilitate passengers travelling to the area before and after enjoying the show. Meanwhile, the East Rail Line will gradually enhance train services starting from the morning.

The Airport Express will also enhance services to accommodate the holiday travelling peak. On Lunar New Year's Day (29 January), the first train from Hong Kong Station to Airport and AsiaWorld-Expo stations will depart early at 5:35am; Meanwhile with extended service hours on the Third to Fifth Days of the Lunar New Year (31 January to 2 February), the last train from AsiaWorld-Expo Station to Hong Kong Station via Airport Station will depart at 1:00am.

As higher passenger volumes are expected during the Lunar New Year period, stations may be crowded, especially after mega events. The Corporation reminds passengers to pay attention to station announcements and signage, follow the instructions of station staff, and remain patient while waiting. When using escalators, passengers should be mindful of safety and maintain courtesy. Passengers can refer to MTR Mobile or the MTR website for train information to help plan their trips in advance. They should stay updated on any additional waiting times that may arise due to crowd management measures implemented by the relevant government departments during mega events. Passengers are advised to reserve sufficient time to enjoy smooth journeys during the festive period.
